Streets Maintenance: Jerry Pickett

Asset Overview:

- 41 Full time employees (FTEs)
- 129 pieces of equipment; loaders, snow plows, mowers
- 380 miles of roadway
- 592 miles of sidewalk

Snow Operations:

- Priority #1 are the main arterials: 35th Ave. 47th Ave. 8th Ave. 10th St. 16th St. 20th St.
- Priority #2 are the bus routes and around schools
- Priority #3 are streets within 2-3 blocks from every house
- Hauling snow from main arterials, ice cutting in sidewalks, and cleaning sidewalks

Patching and Crack Sealing

- Work is done in-house and by contractor
- The goal is to do 200,000 pounds per year and that includes work that has been assess and for the Engineering and Water Departments
- 20,928 potholes last year; the number of potholes has been significantly low since Keep Greeley Moving came into place, it used to be up to 50,000 per year

Graffiti

- 882 locations in 2020
- There are 3-ways to remove graffiti; power washer, chemicals or grey/white paint. Residents have the option of purchasing other shade of paint to cover up graffiti
- Free service to residents of Greeley

Stormwater Maintenance

- Number 3 ditch maintenance
- Catch Basin maintenance done 3 times a year
- Repairing/replacing catch basins

- Detention pond maintenance; there are 344 ponds
- Open ditch maintenance; there are 5 miles of open ditch
- Storm line maintenance; the goal is to do 80,000 feet of storm line clean every year

Street Sweeping

- Routine sweeping; the main arterials are swept 8 times a year, residents streets 3 to 4 times a year, Downtown is done bi-weekly
- After hours calls; accidents

Vegetation

- 600 acres of right-a-way; remove the vegetation and mowed at least 3 times a year
- Spraying
- Weed eating

Other

- Dead animal pickup; 69 pickup last year
- Spring clean up
- Debris and trash clean up; 127 alley calls for trash clean up

Vote for Chair and Vice Chair: Board

The board nominated Mike McFadden and Thomas Donkle for Chair. Thomas was elected by unanimous vote for 2022.

The board nominated Steve Teets and Jimmy Jones for vice chair. Jimmy was elected by unanimous vote for 2022
