5. New Business and Action Items:

a. RAMP Committee

- i. The Stampede has awarded a 100th Anniversary Belt Buckle to our City manager who asked that we frame it and add it to the art collection. Action: Vote to approve accepting this donation into the Permanent Art Collection.
- ii. New Purchase for Downtown The Ramp committee recommends purchasing 'Mecanique Celeste' by Phillipe Pallafray. If approved, this would be purchased with Art Acquisition funds and would help fulfill our pro mise to install artwork downtown on previous Sculpture on Loan pedestal with permanent artwork. Action: vote to approve the purchase of 'Mecanique Celeste' in 2023 purchase for \$18,000 plus installation costs; not to exceed \$25,000.

iii. Art Master Plan

- 1. The committee reviewed an early draft of the 5-year AMP with new capital projects inserted as shown on page 8. Action: Vote to approve adding the capital projects to the Plan.
- 2. Uptown Trees The DDA has requested that the Art Commission add new art trees going North on 8th Ave between 10th & 4th Streets. The Ramp committee recommends adding these future sculpture locations to the Master Plan as new street renovations are done. Action: vote to approve adding these future sculpture locations to the 2023 Art Master Plan as recommended.
- b. Loveland Sculpture in the Park show Follow up; Robb and Eddie attended to look for sculptures that might be good for Greeley in 2023. Kim has gathered information for three sculptures as requested.
- c. 12th St Outfall Art Adam Kuby has gone back to the drawing board and has submitted a preliminary new design. The 12th St Outfall committee thinks it has merit and have asked Adam to continue designing it.

- d. New and ongoing repairs Go West: Centennial Village art fence damage a vehicle was traveling at a rather high speed on 'A' St just west of 14th Ave (south side of the Monfort House), drove up on the sidewalk and damaged 3 fence panels. No painted panels were hit. Stan will contract a fabricator to rebuild/repair the panels.
- a. Paint the Town Traffic Cab update
 - i. The PTT committee met and now recommends that we post a call to artists for new designs this Fall/Winter. Then ask if CDOT will allow us to wrap traffic cabinets on 10th St. in Spring of 2023. If not approved by CDOT, alternate locations will be selected. Action: vote to approve the recommended 2023 10th St traffic cab locations, pending CDOT approval.
 - Kim will move forward with asking LINK library if we can collaborate to install one or two art trees on or near the new building as previously approved by the Art Commission.

- a. The Craig Montgomery art collection that has been donated to the City has all been collected and we are in the process of inventorying the pieces.
- b. Coloring Book Update the committee met to begin discussing plans to change the artwork for 2023. It was agreed that to keep the continuity in the drawings in previous books, we will commission Ann Martinez as our graphic designer again this year if she is available.
- c. Broadview/#3 Ditch trail stamps Installation is being pushed out to the fall 2022.
- d. Fire Station #6 –Looking at an early October installation.
- e. Greeley Funplex Mural in progress Julia Williams has begun painting her mural; you can see the progression by entering the front doors of the Family Funplex and going straight forward to the waiting area. Julia is will mostly be painting on weekdays for the next couple weeks.
- f. New Rodarte Bus Wrap on hold until 2023
- g. Excel Energy Utility Cabinets No change from last report.

Introductions were made for the new CPRD Director, John Dargle.

New Business and Action Items:

- Loveland Sculpture in the Park show Robb and Eddie attended the show to look for sculptures
 that might be good for Greeley. Of the nine sculptures presented, the Art Commission
 suggested that Kim follow up on the following three to present at the September meeting: 'Pas
 de Deux' by Mark Lechleiter, 'Dual Nature' by Kevin Robb and 'She Moves the Stars' by Angela
 Mia De la Vega.
- 2. Arts Picnic Booth for July 30th & 31st suggestions for 2023 included: we need something interactive for visitors to do; we need to update out pop up banners, we need a sign that says VOTE; the purchase of a misting fan would bring customers in; things were blowing over.

Non-Action items:

1. Project Reports:

- a. Marjorie Leggitt has submitted her botanical and nature drawings to Natural Areas & Trails division, and they are being applied to a kiosk at the Island Grove Trailhead along the Poudre Trail.
- b. Uptown Trees 2021-2022 Two new pieces have been successfully installed; Woven Nature by Kiki Goti and Hues of Colorado by Anna Marie Botero & Juan Botero.
- c. Broadview/#3 Ditch trail stamps Installation is being pushed out to the fall 2022.
- d. Fire Station #6 new pics have been submitted showing progress. We might be looking at an early October installation.
- e. Paint the Town

- i. Greeley Funplex Mural –on Schedule Julia Williams has been contracted to paint her mural in September 2022.
- ii. Island Grove Arena Murals Armando Silva and Cody Kuehl have completed painting the two main entry gates to the Island Grove Arena.
- iii. New Rodarte Bus Wrap on hold until 2023
- iv. Excel Energy Utility Cabinets No change from last report.

2. Maintenance & Repair

- a. Dancing in the Rain has been relocated to the existing planter between 14th and 15th Streets on the west side. The previous location on the corner of 8th Ave and 11th St will be restored to a safe sidewalk level and no longer used as an Uptown Tree location.
- b. Graffiti removed from Centennial & Peakview Skatepark art. The access panel on the Peakview artwork has once again been removed. We have purchased new security bolts and used Loctite to try to foil another attempt of it being removed.
- c. Balsam Park The painted designs on the stone 'bear cave' have been repainted (they were previously removed due to vandalism. Wes also gave painting the concrete under a shelter another try and unfortunately it is peeling. The concrete must have an incredible resistant mixed in with it because it seems to repel everything. We will not be able to paint the concrete; it was an added bonus by Wes and not a required element.
- **d.** 'The History of Greeley Transportation' Artist Kirk Seese done some preliminary repair and will follow up with the artwork in September.
- **e.** Q3 2022 Survey Monkey art inspection reminders will soon go out via email. Please let Stan know if you have questions.
