**5. New Business and Action Items:**

- a. Utility Cab update – Paint the Town committee recommends the GAC add art wraps on ALLO cabinets as part of the Paint the Town ongoing program (see pgs. 4-5). We have the opportunity to sign an agreement with ALLO Communications to add vinyl art wraps to their new cabinets. They have 24 boxes in place and plan to have a total of 40 cabinets in Greeley in the next few years. ALLO boxes are all in City right of ways. ALLO has given 2 citizens approval to wrap two cabinets not knowing our process; they have apologized and asked how to move forward. If we can approve these 2 designs today, which is after the fact, that would be great. We can also choose whether to accept them as donations that would require us to maintain them.  
[ACTION - Vote to approve 1\) two ALLO cabinet designs that are on city property and 2\) Vote to approve accepting the wraps as donations to the collection and taking on maintenance for the wraps.](#)
- b. Master Plan addition – the RAMP committee recommends adding an ‘Art Fence to Meeker Museum’ project to the At Master Plan. While there isn’t a set time on when this could happen, the mention of it in the AMP is deemed appropriate.

- c. New art Donation – RAMP recommends accepting the artwork titled ‘The Erechtheion’ by Robb Casseday. The 18x24 artwork is framed and is valued at \$670.

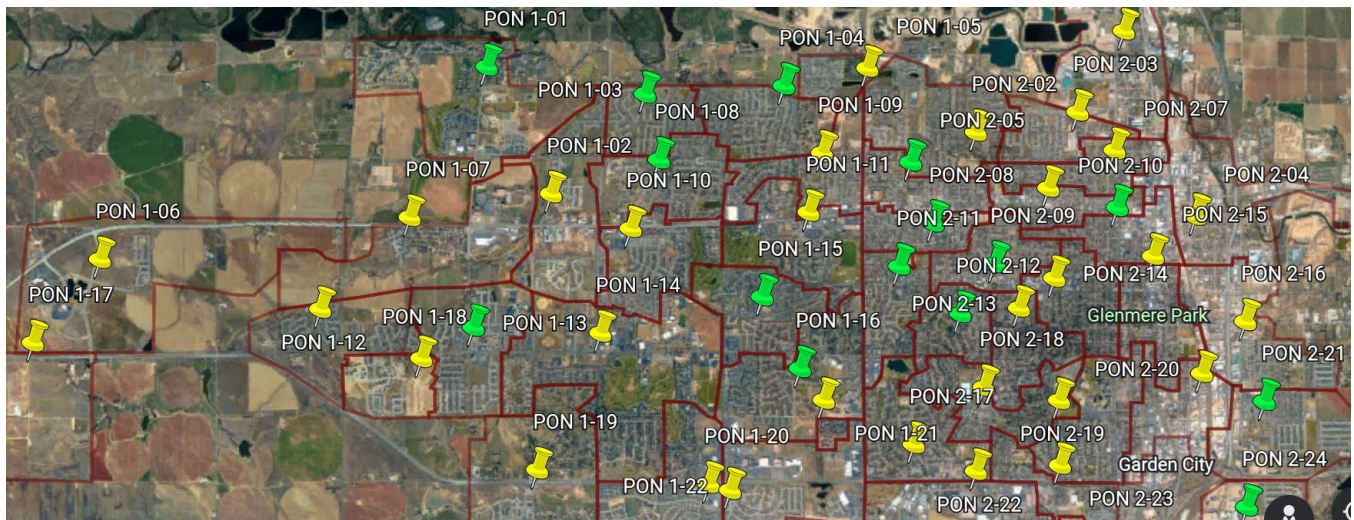

ALLO PON Cabinets are located in the City ROW, on city property, and measure 64Hx33Wx17D

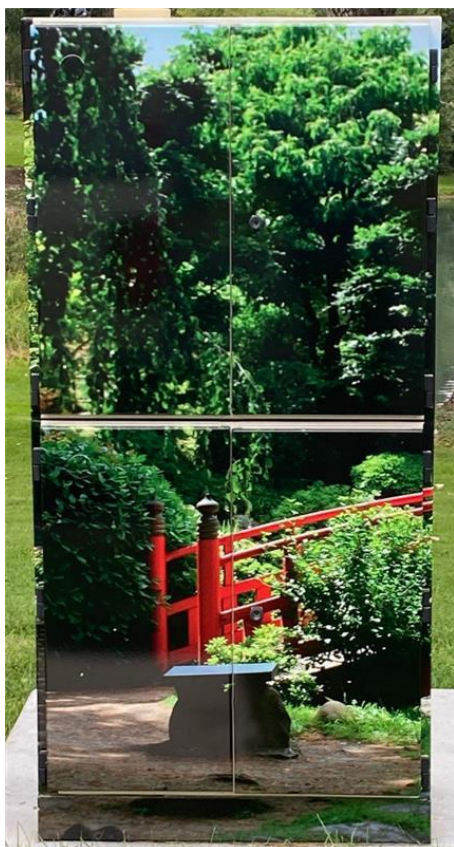
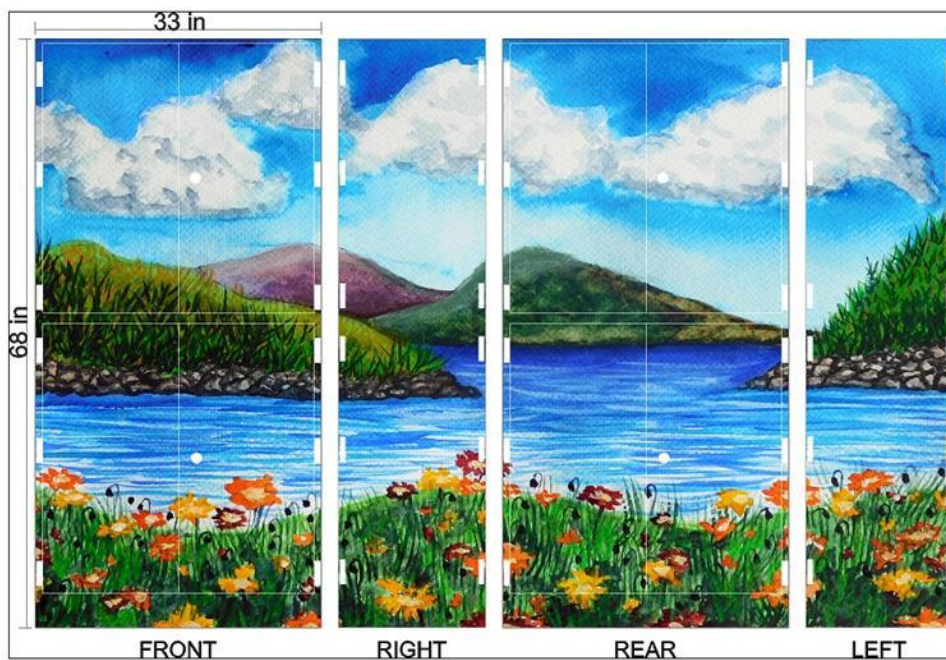
