Major Events

- Chris attended Scenic and Historic Byways Commission meeting: Chris is a state Commissioner representing the Cache la Poudre North Park byway, and the Pawnee Pioneer Trails byway.
- Much of the month revolved around 2024 Budget setting, with Museums writing 10 Budget Increase Requests
- We also wrote and submitted an ARPA grant application for relandscaping and interpretive planning for Meeker Home
- Chris received and submitted to Finance a substantial donation (\$50,000) from the Union Colony Company of Colorado for the Agricultural Heritage Center feasibility work.
 Our full and sincere thanks to UCCoC for this support! Work is ongoing to contract our architectural consultant.
- Chris captured a 3D image of the White Plumb Farm statue prior to its removal to create a lasting record.
- All hands were on deck for the Spring History Fest. We hosted over 3000 students, teachers and parents!
- Geoff, Holly, Katie Ross, JoAnna and Chris attended the annual American Alliance of Museum conference in Denver. There were thousands of attendees from across the country there, and we all attended a number of informative sessions many of which confirmed COGM's direction is following national trends – and ahead of the game in some areas.
- Chris, Holly, Adriana and Anthony also attended the annual Dearfield Conference in Fort Collins. Both Chris and Holly are on the Dearfield committee of the Black American West Museum and helped run the conference, with Holly presenting.
- Both Chris and Geoff attended several meetings about a new parking lot for Centennial Village to be built south of A Street opposite the existing parking lot. We are working with Roads to identify the right design that will best meet the needs for occasional overflow and buses.
- Geoff Trained and led interpretive staff through Spring Field Trip Season including School Field Trips, History Fest, and Centennial Celebration.
- Adriana attended the Cultural Awareness Training at the Golden History Museum on May 25th.
- Sadly, The exhibit *Bittersweet Harvest: The Bracero Program, 1942-1964* closed to the public on 5/13. The Exhibits, Collections, and Registrar teams deinstalled the exhibit the following week. During its display period, the exhibit reached 2,969 visitors to GHM. The next exhibit in the Mezzanine will open on 6/22.
- We successfully acquired a gift from Richard and Diane Borys of ledgers once belonging to OT Jackson, the founder of Dearfield. These ledgers include incredible, and rare, details of OT's businesses in Boulder in the late 19th century, and the foundation of Dearfield itself. These will be a tremendous resource in the National Park Services upcoming Special Resource Study into the possible creation of a Dearfield National Historic Site.

• Katie Ross Completed a guide for Centennial Village interpretive staff to know where use (L3/L4) items are on display in the historic homes vs. permanent collection items.





April 20, 2023, Museum Advisory Board Meeting Minutes Motion to approve by Floris Mikkelson seconded by Marcus Embry. The motion passed unanimously.

Culture, Parks, and Recreation Department Report (John Dargle): The entire department is working on the 2024 budget. Candidates for the Deputy Director of the Culture, Park, and Recreation Department are being narrowed down for interviews. The Cultural Affairs Manager position is still open and being bid out to a third-party recruiter for a nationwide search.

Culture Division Report (Andrea Haring): No official updates currently.

Museums Report (Chris Bowles): 2024 Budget Increase requests include staff and operations increases at both Greeley History Museum and Centennial Village. Those requests include several positions and large equipment needed at Centennial Village. The American Alliance of Museums Conference is in Denver this week and we were able to get quotes for designers for Meeker and the Agricultural Heritage building at Centennial Village. The Museum's division appealed the city-wide comp and class final decisions due to some errors; this is still in process for employees. Barry Alvarado and Ann Abbath have been boosted in pay grade and title position. Our guest tracking by zip code continues and we are still getting visitors from outside of Colorado as well as across the front range all the way down to Pueblo. Finally got a signature from the donor of the Dearfield Ledgers so they are now in the Museum Collection.

Friends of the Greeley Museums Report (Floris Mikkelson): Still working on the website for memberships. Discussing the budget for the 2023 Potato Day.

Public/Board Input - Committee Reports:

• Experiences Team (Mike/George) – Dearfield Study Q & A will be the next Museum at Twilight Event on June 10th at the Hensel Phelps Theatre in the Union Colony Civic Center. The ticket office at the UCC was able to assist us in the

ticket processing for this event. The next exhibit featuring a Curator's Corner on Habitat for Humanity is scheduled to open on June 22nd. We are all set to host the Dolores Huerta Revolutions in the Field traveling exhibit from the Smithsonian in September. Looking to tell local stories from the people in Weld County who worked with Dolores during her time here. Partnering with the Greeley Philharmonic Orchestra for the Seven Symphonic Portraits performance at UCC on October 14th, installing a portable exhibit for review in the lobby of UCC as people enter the performance then moving that to GHM as part of a larger exhibit. Our previous audio tour has switched from Oncell to Stgry quality control testing occurred at History Fest and managing database management regarding content. Analytics tracking has unfortunately dropped when switching from Oncell to Stqry, so we are working on plans for the Analytics. Weld Towns' outgoing traveling exhibit has been requested again. At Centennial Village Baby Animal Days had lower attendance than expected which is believed to be weather related with rain and snow. The Steven Reynolds project has been delayed this year due to the weather we hope to have this project complete later this summer. The Spring History Fest was an exciting access. Poudre Heritage Alliance reached out last month about a possible partnership. Centennial Village is now fully staffed which has everyone getting trained and upkeep projects continue.

 Acquisitions Committee (Marcus/Staff) – Received some items from Weld County Ambulance including scrapbooks, photos, thank you letters, newspaper clippings, uniforms, and a tool kit. Bridle and Photos about Willie the trained Brahma.
